
1 Overview








1.2 Wiki (external)

1.3 BLOG



Having said this, it is evident that we will not come up with a BI-solution being superior to existing solutions, let's say from (make an educated guess) Business Objects, which have been developed over by several thousands of people. Instead, we will focus on some specific aspects of BI which can complement existing solutions.
